We are really pleased with our great fundraising progress. Our main activity is the Pond House Renovation appeal. We have achieved a wonderful 73.3 % of our £613,000 target and are now on our final push to completion. You won't be surprised to know that we have experienced some delays due to Covid-19. Our Pond House opening will be several months later than planned. However, the good news is that our Project Manager is taking things forward in a very encouraging way.

We are delighted to have been awarded so many donations from all of you generous donors and supporters, Trusts & Foundations, as well as the generous and very kind gestures from you dear friends and families. Such amazing efforts mean a great deal to all of us at the Mount. We are truly proud and grateful that we have raised £448,764! A huge thank you to everyone!
